

Then came the part we love best, distributing the money to non-profit agencies in Oro Valley and Tucson who provide much needed help to "at risk" kids enabling them to get on track and stay on track. In short, that is the mission of the SCCF.

"...helping 'at risk' kids get on track and stay on track." In 2009, we were able to award 7 grants for a total of \$106,200 followed in 2010 by 11 grants totaling \$145,000. In addition to the two fundraisers, the sources of these funds included a one-time donation from The Stone Canyon LLC, matching funds from the Diamond Family Foundation and Wells Fargo, and generous annual donations by individual SC members.


