Museum School for the Visual Arts

Mosade Virgil, age 17 and a 2011 Graduate of the Museum School for the Visual Arts (MSVA), answers the question, "Why did you choose to go to the MSVA?"



Mosade Virgil

"I've always liked art. I've been drawing ever since I could write. I didn't like regular high school. I wasn't popular and no one ever talked to me. Here the teachers allow us to create what we like. We aren't censored as much as we are in a regular high school.

Eventually, I would like to be a make-up effects artist. I am currently completing an apprenticeship with a local make-up effects artist, Michael Peterson. I would like to eventually work for him.

After graduation, I would like to continue working, so I can gain experience. I also think I would like to go to college. I believe I could get a job on experience alone, but I think I should at least get the minimum of four years in college.

At MSVA, my grades have gotten better. I used to get nothing but low C's and D's. Now my grades are much higher. There is no such thing as popularity at MSVA. We accept and deal with everyone."

Without SCCF support of the MSVA, Mosade and others like him would likely be high school dropouts. Through your donations, these young adults are able to complete high school and go on to even greater accomplishments. The SCCF has awarded Grants to the MSVA for the past three years.

Where's The Money?

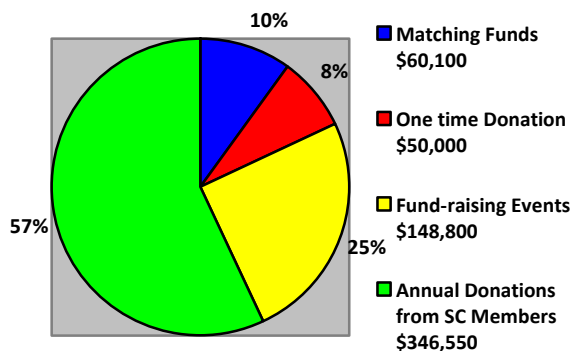
IN 2010 - 2011, THE SCCF DONATED OVER \$171,800!

In addition to our two fundraisers, the sources of these funds included matching funds from the Diamond Family Fund and the generous Annual Fund Donations made by individual SC members.

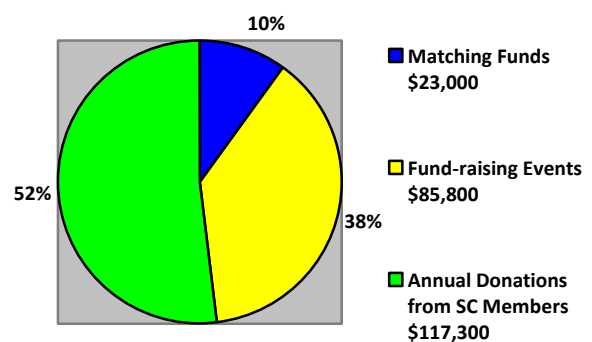
Let's look at our fund-raising for the last three years as well as how we did in 2010-11 fiscal year.

2011 SCCF Grant Award Recipients

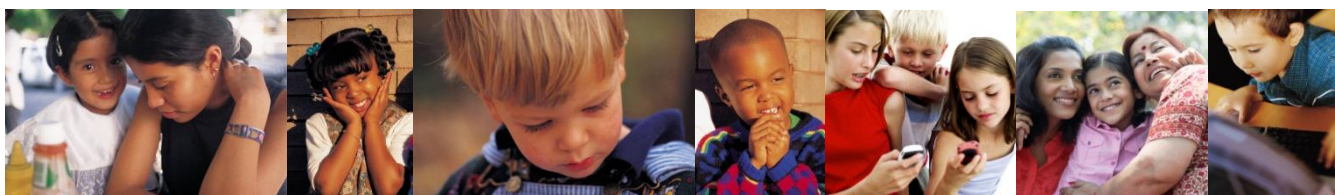
