Jansen and His Family

Perhaps you attended Denim, Dinner an' Dancin' the year that Jansen Azarias told us how Higher Ground started in his living room in 2007 while tutoring an ever-growing group of teens. Jansen soon discovered there were many students in the south side of Tucson who shared the experiences of a low-performing school, broken families, gang

affiliations, crime, drug abuse, incarcerated parents, poverty, and an

Today, Higher Ground reaches 150 students who receive daily homework tutoring and enrichment activities such as football, dance, jujutsu, art, boxing, bike club, and choir. Students also receive training in financial literacy and character development. Higher Ground expands its program every year and has partnered with the Tucson Unified School District to move into the historic Wakefield Middle School. The organization has also partnered with eight other faith-based groups and five community organizations, as well as with several departments at the University of Arizona, Phoenix University, and Pima Community College.

With the help of these partners and the commitment of more than 50 volunteers, students and their parents pay nothing for participating. All programs are coordinated by a small staff of five people and have an annual budget of \$150,000. Even with this small staff, students and parents can reach Higher Ground 24/7 if they need anything from financial assistance to an intervention.

Earlier this spring, Jansen invited several Stone Canyon members for breakfast at Wakefield Middle School where Higher Ground now operates. After breakfast, Jansen presented us with a plaque and said, "in recognition of the support provided by the Stone Canyon Community Foundation, an area where the students gather after school is now named, The Stone Canyon Café!" We were surprised and proud to have played even a small part in the success of this impressive organization. 
A warm welcome is extended to the new BOD members: John Carhart and Dan Carpenter. We look forward to working with you to keep the SCCF momentum going!

Sources of SCCF Funds


In addition to our two fundraisers, the sources of SCCF funds included matching funds from the Diamond Family Fund and the generous Annual Fund Donations made by individual SC members.
