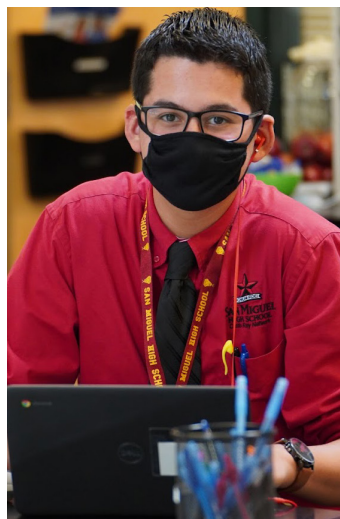
13 YEARS OF GIVING AND OVER \$3 MILLION DONATED



Keeping in line with 2019-2020, we continued to be flexible with our foundation efforts, adjusting to the pandemic environment. We extended our Annual Appeal timeframe well into the fall, followed by our November event/silent auction and wrapping up the year with our Spirit of Giving drive through item collection benefiting Make Way for Books and Youth on Their Own.

Many thanks to our Stone Canyon members, who once again, rose to the donation challenge – from drive by event donations, to salsa making and most importantly, to your continued financial support. Your financial donations allowed our foundation to continue funding an average of \$250,000 in grants per year. Our grants support between 20-25 grantees annually, all with the mission of directly benefiting Tucson area's youth-at-risk.

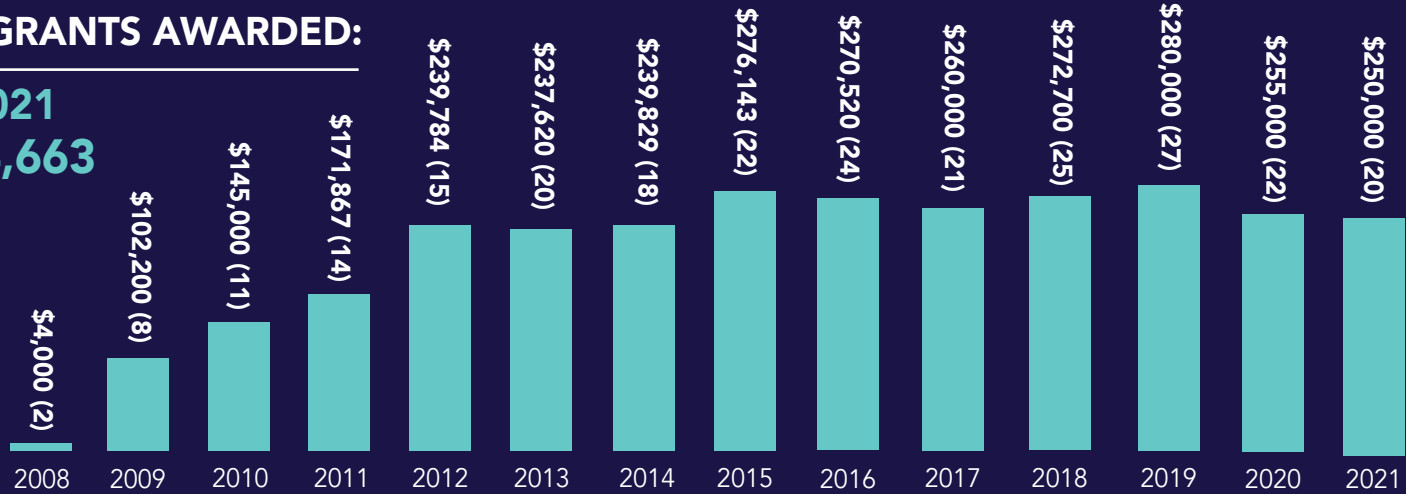
