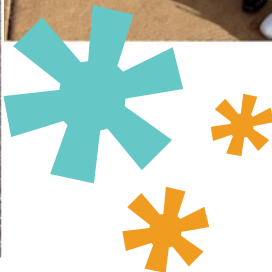


### 6<sup>th</sup> Annual SPIRIT OF GIVING

#### **Navigating the Tucson Gem & Mineral Show**

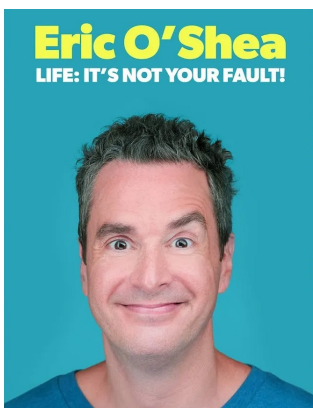

Many members and guests enjoyed an entertaining evening with Eric O'Shea, one of the most sought-after CLEAN comedians in entertainment.

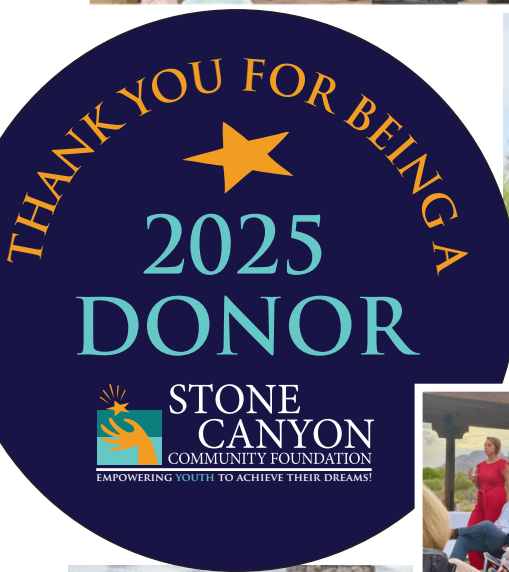
